Earn Extra Money! *Become a* **Member Organizer**

If you sever your employment from a HHWA shop, you still have the opportunity to work as a member organizer for the HHWA. This can be done in several ways:

1. By joining the HHWA Retiree Chapter, you will remain an active member of the HHWA and can supplement your income by assisting the union with the organizing of new workers. If you recommend and/or assist the union in organizing a group of workers, you will be compensated if the HHWA is successful in obtaining a contract for these workers. Please call the Business Agent for your former employer for more information.
2. If you obtain employment at a non-union employer, you can still be a member organizer if you assist the HHWA in organizing your new employer. You can help your new co-workers obtain better wages, benefits and working conditions, and continue to participate in the Security Fund without losing your vested status (if you rejoin the HHWA within 12 months.) On top of all these reasons to help the union organize your new workplace, as a Member Organizer who has assisted in the growth of this Union, you will be paid for your efforts once the first contract is negotiated at your new employer. And, you can also help the Union organize other employees for a fee. Any referral you make that leads to a new group of workers enjoying the benefits of a union contract will entitle you to a Member Organizer fee.
There is no limit to how often you can do this.

So, contact your friends, family, and other employees working within your industry and area, to bring the benefits of unionization to them. Not only will you earn extra money, you will also strengthen your bargaining clout, resulting in better contracts for all Union members. Adding members strengthens the Union, which equates to greater contract gains.
